The Children's Task Force is the child abuse and neglect council serving Franklin County, Maine, and is a prevention agency that utilizes a strengths-based approach to supporting local families through administration of its Maine Families Home Visiting program, community trainings and parent enrichment workshops, and its various school-based initiatives. FCCTF participates in statewide efforts to raise awareness of and engage Maine citizens in conversations around ACEs and resilience, an example of which is its active membership in the Maine Resilience Building Network. In addition, FCCTF hosts public screenings and discussions of the film Paper Tigers, coordinates local professional trainings around the topic of ACEs, promotes access to the information via newsletters and social media postings, and is currently in a three-year grant cycle to promote protective factors locally (and thus, resilience) using a socio-ecological model for preventing and responding to child maltreatment.
